Requirements:

10	Grades – 2.5 GPA minimum. A transcript must accompany the application.

25	Character Reference <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Teacher, Principal or Counselor➤ A personal letter➤ Other (Minister, Employer, Group Leader, etc.)
40	Essay on “What does it mean to be a part of your community and how have the activities and community service shaped who you are.”

There will be one scholarship awarded to a Senior at Kootenai High School and one scholarship awarded to a Senior at St Maries High School in the amount of \$200, which will be awarded for the second semester of school.

Any graduating Senior, who meets the minimum requirements, and is a student at Kootenai High School or St Maries High School is eligible to apply.

Applicant must be planning on attending a university, college, or a trade school to complete an education in their chosen field.
